Overview and Concept

Covert Conversion Pro (CCP) will track **ALL** of your marketing activities that are generating traffic AND sales, whether these sales are a result of promoting **Affiliate Programs** or from promoting your **Own** products.

These marketing activities can be:

- PPC: Google Adwords, Yahoo Search Marketing, MSN Adcenter
- Organic traffic from search engines
- Other environments: Email, Ezine, Text Link Ad, Partners, Signature, Forums, Videos, Blog Posts, Guestbooks

In the first 2 above, covert conversion pro tracks all of the keywords which generate traffic AND sales, thus letting you know which keywords convert the best. The benefit of this of course is so you can optimize your PPC campaigns for these keywords and your landing pages or sales pages for these keywords. It means that you can eliminate all the non profitable side of your monetizing strategy.

Finally, by allowing you to track all of your other sources of traffic (other environments) you can have a wholistic approach to traffic conversion. All of the traffic not related to a keyword search, but to a link displayed in a given environment. (For example, you write a newsletter and want to track the conversion from this newsletter. This script will create a simple link that will track conversion, whether you're promoting an affiliate program or your own product)

In other words: in this case, you do not track keyword, but the "environment" which generated the traffic and the sale.

This is what Covert Conversion Pro is about : which keyword, which environment are converting the best for your affiliate programs, your own products, AND how you can optimize your whole traffic generation and traffic conversion strategies.

Important Features

Before we enter the core of this user's guide, let's describe some of the important features you should want to use.

Covert Conversion Pro is user friendly and has been developed to simplify things for you:

- Covert Conversion Pro is based on a well known and used promotion structure: **Campaigns & Ads**.
- A Campaign is a set of ads from which you want to measure results.

- A Campaign is usually related to a given project or program you're promoting.
- Ads inside these campaigns will help you better target your promotion.

- Major problems with similar scripts are that
 1. you often need to import your keywords from your PPC service (Adwords, Search Marketing, MSN) to then track them from the tracking script...thus missing a lot of potential visitors / traffic sources
 2. you need to create your landing pages, upload them, edit them
 3. you need to change your PPC ads to incorporate a tracking ID

- Covert Conversion Pro will let you structure your promotions into campaigns & ads so that you can match your current promotion habits

- CCP won't ask you to change anything to your existing ads or listings (if you're sending traffic to a landing page. If you're directing traffic directly to the affiliate page, then you can do it, but you will need to edit the URL within your listing). **Anyway, in 2007, no one should ever send traffic directly to an affiliate page as your CPC will be much higher than if you redirect it even to a basic landing page.**

- To track your conversions from an affiliate program, you will simply select the affiliate network, give the URL of the product you're promoting, and the script will create the landing (redirect) page for you. In this case, all you have to do is redirect your PPC traffic to this URL. **If you are a more advanced marketer and have tons of campaigns and ads to track CCP has a mass import feature (csv file) which will import all of your campaigns and ads at one time and also create all of the redirect or landing pages at the same time. This can save you literally tons of hours!**

- If you are already sending traffic to a landing page (through PPC or other traffic sources) then the script will give you a code snippet to include in your page to track everything (this way, you don't change your PPC listing)

- To get the final conversion of keywords, you will then import your sales data from the affiliate network (from CB, CJ, Linkshare) and the script will show you the converting keywords. **(CCP will parse the sales data files searching for "keyword", "search", "query", "kw", "keyw", "kword" so as to be compatible with most any affiliate network files)**

- To track conversion from one of your own products (difference is that when this is your own product, you do have access to the thank you page as it is yours), script will provide the code for both landing page and thank you page and will track everything on its own.

- Pages automatically created by the system can be fully edited with the build-in HTML editor.
- **The script can create landing page either locally** (where you installed the script) **or on any other server you have access to** (which is really convenient when you want to raise your quality score)
- You can configure as many affiliate networks as you want and script will automatically and instantly learn to track them. All you will need is to upload the CSV file from your sales data from this affiliate network. (CCP will parse the sales data files searching for "keyword", "search", "query", "kw", "keyw", "kword" so as to be compatible with most any affiliate network files)
- Reports are created for each campaign / ad

How Do I Install Covert Conversion Pro

Step 1: Create a MySQL database.

Step 2: Upload all files and folders to the hosting account.

Step 3: CHMOD/Set Permissions

- a) temp_data folder - 757 or 777
- b) trackingpages folder - 757 or 777
- c) config folder - 757 or 777

Step 4: Call up the install.step1.php file in browser.

Use your browser and go to this url:

Replace "yourdomain.com" above with your own domain name where the script is installed. Replace "foldername" above with the name of the folder you installed the script into.

Step 5: Fill out the form with the appropriate information and then click the button to continue.

Step 6: Fill in your contact email, username and password you wish to use for admin center. Click the button to complete the install.

Step 7: Make sure to delete the files mentioned on the last page of install procedure. Then click the link to access the admin center login page.

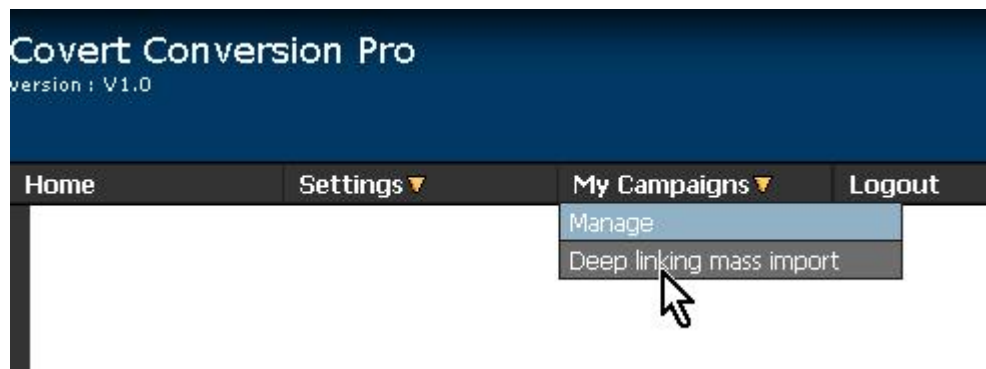
SPECIAL FEATURE: DEEP LINKING MASS IMPORT

Are you doing more full time marketing efforts and you have tons of campaigns and ads to track? Then we have a special feature you are going to just love!

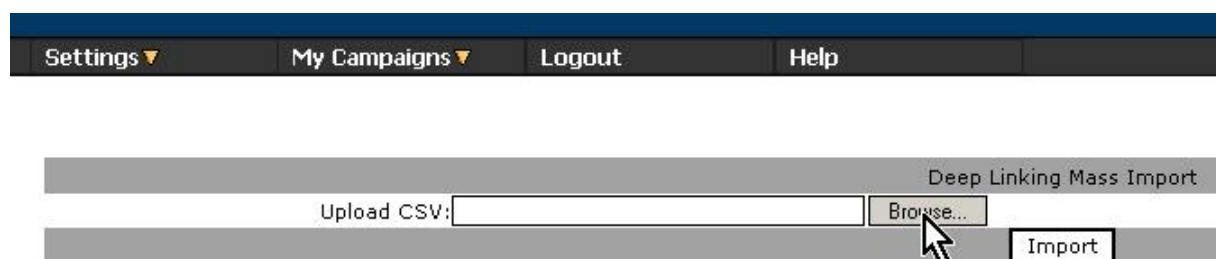
You can create a CSV file (comma delimited text file) of all your campaigns and corresponding ads and mass import all of them into CCP at once. While CCP is importing all of your campaigns and ads it will also automatically create all of your redirect/landing pages at the same time! This one feature alone can save you literally hundreds of hours over time!

TO USE THIS FEATURE:

Go to “My Campaigns”, then select from the menu “Deep linking mass import”.



Then click on the “Browse” button which will open a new window where you can select the .csv file from your computer.



Then you only need to click on the “Import” button to import the file and the system will import all the records, setup each campaign along with its corresponding ads, and finally the system will create each redirect/landing page as it is importing the file records.

As you see, the only difference in Scenario 2 and Scenario 1 is that in Scenario 2 you would select "Contextual" for the Environment.

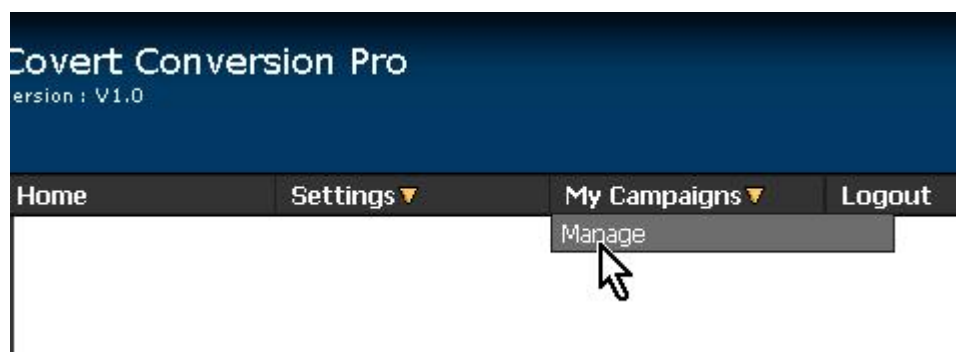
What it does in the background and why Sc.1 is different from Sc.2 : in scenario 1, a tracking ID is created on the fly and stored depending on which keyword your visitor used to get to your site. In scenario 2, a tracking ID is assigned at the moment you create the ad. This tracking ID is assigned to the ad (ie to the email you're about to send).

IMPORTANT: The thank you page and the sales letter MUST be on the same domain. If you sell a product at domainA.com/index.php then your thank you page MUST be at domainA.com too.

IMPORTANT BIS: If you use a centralized system to manage your sales, such as JVManager 1 or Fantasos, here is the trick to track your sales even if the thank you page is not on the same domain than the sales letter.

In this case, the following needs to be done:

- Sales letter is located on domain A
- User is redirected to server B after purchase is completed. This page on server B will be a redirect to Server A.
