

Introduction

Changing the MAC address is illegal in some countries, it is up to you to abide by the relevant laws.

This application is designed to change the MAC address under OS X Snow Leopard. It has not been tested on any other OS. It may not work at all for some Ethernet/Wireless cards, so test it before buying.

Select an interface from the drop down list. In theory you shouldn't need to select one, as the first one listed should be your ethernet connection.

Information relative to that interface is shown, such as IP address, MAC address etc. You can refresh this information by clicking the "Refresh" button.

Enter a new MAC address in the "New MAC" edit box. You can use a prefix from a manufacturer, simply select from the drop down list. You can also randomly generate a new address using the "Random" button.

When ready, use the "Set" button to change the MAC address. If required, you will need to enter any administrator username/password in order to change the MAC address.

Note that internet activity will be disrupted/unavailable while MAC address changing takes place.

After about 10 seconds the information will be updated to reflect any changes.

The original (real) MAC address can be reinstated by rebooting your computer.

The app resides in the menu bar area of your screen (usually in the top right) and you can access it by clicking on it's black icon. This will display a menu from which you can display the app's main window, change its preferences, set/view network preferences and more.

Preferences



Show app window when app starts

Displays the main window when the app is started, otherwise you have to access it from the menu bar pull down menu.

Start app when you start your Mac

MacAppStuff Spoof MAC is started when your Mac starts.

Generate a random MAC address when application starts

Does exactly as it says, saves you (lazy people) from clicking the Random button or typing in a MAC address.

Trial Limitations

The trial is designed to run for 14 days. After this time you will either need to purchase a license from our website (see below), or remove it from your computer. The vendor prefixes are not available in the trial.

How to buy

If you are truly satisfied with the software and have fully evaluated it for 14 days, you can purchase a license online from our website (go to the product page and click the Buy button).

PayPal handle our payments. You need a working email address to purchase the software. Once you have made your purchase, you will receive an email from PayPal confirming the transaction, and an email from us (usually within 24 - 48 hours) which will include you're your license and a download link to the software.

Your license becomes void if it is used by someone else to activate the software, if a refund is issued or your payment is fraudulent.
