Install Instructions

Introduction

- To run the SBS Database, you will need Microsoft Access installed. Our products will run on Microsoft Access 2007, 2010, 2013, and 2016.
- If you do not have Microsoft Access installed, you may download and install the free runtime version of Access from the Microsoft website:
<http://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=10910>
- Once Microsoft Access is installed, **extract or unzip the database file** included in the zip file and save it locally. Do not launch the database from within the.zip file.
- Launch the database once it has been extracted / unzipped.
- Do not launch or open the database file from inside the zip file.

Demo products

- Each database is a demo product which allows the user to install and run the product 25 times.
- After the 25th time, the product must be purchased and a valid registration product Key will be provided. Once entered, this product key will activate the user license.
- In this way, a user may enter actual data in the demo version which will not be lost when the product is registered.

Other SBS products

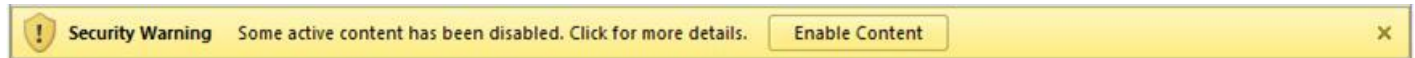

Simply download the file, unzip it and save it locally (if necessary), and copy the file to the desired location on your hard drive. You may launch the file normally.

Sunday Business Systems recommends saving the Database in a Trusted Location using Trusted Center. The Trust Center is a dialog box that provides a single location for setting and changing security settings for Access. You use the Trust Center to create or change trusted locations and to set security options for Access. Those settings affect how new and existing databases behave when they are opened in that instance of Access. The Trust Center also contains logic for evaluating the components in a database and for determining whether the database is safe to open or whether the Trust Center should disable the database and let you decide to enable it.
